- Kenwood TDMA is still not working. Kenwood provided a version of firmware that they felt was the solution. It did not work. It has been requested that Kenwood engineers come to West Virginia to fix the problem. Motion by Steve Vititoe to move the NX series of radios to Level 99 pending solution. Second by Dan Kirby. Passed.
- RC Faulk will notify users of pending Master Site patching set to occur in August 2023. Small impacts will be seen.
- Dustyn met with Randy Kinsolving regarding programming issues that came to our attention. Talkgroups were found in the codeplugs that shouldn't be there. Law Enforcement in Fire radios, DOT3 and DHSEM in Fire Radios. It is recommended that a document be created by Dustyn and submitted to Dave Saffel and Bob Hoge to make a determination if any changes were needed.
- Fiber will be installed at Malden Mountain within the next 6 months.
