## <u>Technical Committee Report – Dave Saffel</u>

• System Stats

- Testing Motorola Next Radio
  - O Current Next radio provided is locked and cannot be tested as some features are missing from the test radio. Motorola has not met the requirements of the policy for testing after repeated notifications. Committee recommends that Motorola be given until October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 and if the policy requirements are not met, the testing will be discontinued and the radio will not be approved for use on SIRN. Jim Mangus second. Motion passed.
- The Catherines Site has been PM'ed. All base stations are between 40 and 42 watts out. Channel 6 has been turned on and all frequencies are matching what is licensed. The RX antenna is going to be relocated away from a cellular array and on another leg to see if there is a service change for the Wadestown area.
- The Laurel Tower has gotten all new antennas. Fred Kinder is going to go PM the site following the updates. Preston County has been given a radio programming change suggestion.
- Kanawha County is testing a new emergency talkgroup to move sheriff emergencies away from the dispatch talkgroup so that it will be only received at certain console positions at the dispatch center. Jim Mangus advised test is working so far. Additional questions remain about different brands/models and what about field users getting the emergency if the button moves the declaring radio to another talkgroup.
- The governor's office is interested in a single button statewide on every subscriber unit to make all users to a single talkgroup for a mass casualty event. Further discussion forthcoming at the Conference.



- Tim Priddy and Dustyn McConnel briefed on a new program with WVU Medicine grant providing medical doctors responding in outfitted vehicles. Committee recommends that two talkgroups be created in each of the medical command regions labeled PHYS 1 and PHYS 2 to be used by the doctors to coordinate amongst themselves. Also, the radio ID management from the doctors will follow the WVU ID block range. Second by Fred Channell. Motion Passed.
- Brooke County reached out about extending trunking service within the Brooke County Schools. Jeff Polczynski has experience with BDA's and will reach out to the Brooke County POC.
- Blue Ridge site antennas are scheduled to be installed on Thursday of this week.
- On the 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> of August, the new DC power plants will be installed at PK and Malden sites.
- The Belleville site will need a second site controller before it can be brought in service.
- The State Police Academy asked for three talkgroups to be created for academy training use only with limited access to just Coal and Garfield sites. **Committee recommends approval, Fred Channel second. Motion Passed.**
