- Do we want to have midyear programming classes, and if so, where, and who is going to be the instructor? We need to determine some locations, Instructors, etc. Try to prepare ideas.
- L3Harris Class – Comments were positive about the L3 Class. I think many learned including the instructor. Thank you to Alex Rayburn from the National Guard who I asked to attend. He was a great help, and added many positive aspects to the class. Jeremy Stanley from Discount Communications also added significantly to the class. Thank you to all who attended our first ever L3Harris class, and I hope it will be better the second time! Persons needing a 4-year hardware key need to purchase it from L3Harris then get with Programming Instructor staff to get the keys authorized.

- If you are programming XL-200 radios, be certain that you do NOT have LTE box checked unless you have subscribed for LTE. Going to check Tuesday, but is there a purpose to having LTE connection if BEON is not active in the SIRN system?
- Be CERTAIN that you have the Channel IDEN (ID List) correct. We are hearing about many radios that still have #3 active still. This can cause problems making radios lockup. Your chair experienced this with EF Johnson radios many years ago when we have Channel ID's 1 & 2 checked as active in those radios. This caused them to lockup. I think the lockup is really the radio searching for a control channel potentially, but I can't guarantee that is what is happening.
- BK – RES class – This first effort at teaching the RES software went well to the best of my knowledge. Mike Bath of BK helped by providing help getting the Child Keys created. Persons needing a 4-year hardware key need to purchase it from BK Technologies and then get with Programming Instructor staff to get the keys authorized. Jeremy Stanley from Discount Communications was again very helpful in this first BK class ever conducted.
- Dustyn and I are members of MTUG (Motorola Trunked Users Group) – We are seeing many complaints about the N70 radio that is here for testing. Based on that, we are NOT recommending that it be approved yet to purchase or add to the system. If you have had any attempt by Motorola to sell you N70 radios, they are NOT approved.
- The programming classes revealed locations that had problems with L3Harris radios locking up on them. None have been reported to L3Harris except by EMD to the best of my knowledge, but we do not plan to approve any more of the L3Harris radios until these issues are resolved totally.
- Note that a correction has been made to the Channel ID plans for numbers 6 and 7. The Bandwidth had been listed as 6.25 kHz, but we realized that the width of the channel was still 12 kHz, but it was divided digitally into two channels that were the EQUIVALENT of 6.25 KHz. Also note the addition of Channel ID 8.
- Vendor Sierra Two Way Communications has asked for access to the system and a talkgroup to provide demo vehicles to sell the system to customers. We have never allowed this in the past and are apprehensive about setting this as precedent. Normally, if a vendor wants to provide demo, they can go to the county and provide a demo radio to them using one of their IDs for the demo. At this time, the Technical Committee will table this issue.
- Mountain Transit Authority has asked to be valid in Clay, Monroe and Braxton County. Motion from Adam Gianato, Second Tony Novel. No one opposed.

- There is a desire to add TDMA to the Beaver Valley due to the site being only three channels. In order to facilitate this, we needed to add a Channel ID to be able to use TDMA. In anticipation of this being added to the Beaver Valley Site, Channel ID 8 has been created and is now going to be attached to our minutes from this point forward.
- Richard Rose emailed that T-Mobile wanted to go on their Hodam Mt. site. We looked at the structural analysis as Richard indicated that their antenna would just below our receive antenna. In looking at the structural, it appears that it is only 10 feet below our antenna with no clear picture of if their antenna length was even more in proximity of the SIRN antenna. We desire that no antenna is located within 30 feet of a SIRN antenna.

- WV Aux Comm, October 25 & 26 Romney, sent registration information out. WVSIRN Conference, radio programming training Wednesday and Thursday.
- Old Business
  - S. Yoho advised at our last Ric meeting that the Wileyville/Wetzel tower construction has been delayed by weather. Fence not up yet. Electrical not completed. Microwave obstructed from Boston Hill to WTZ 911 center, relicense and move up on the tower at BH.
  - Cadel everything signed, all studies done. Steel being ordered, in cue to be manufactured. Won't have to relicense. Both towers will co exist.
  - Sand Springs had a bad antenna, repaired and back to normal.

  - ICE brought a block of RID's to SIRN and were issued TG's.
  - For those attending and taking either BK or L3 Harris classes, in order to leave the conference with a programming key, you must have a distribution key that will be authorized. No Master Keys will be authorized.
  - Technical Committee would like to recommend all radios in Level 1 have the ability to do Mixed Mode Priority Scan feature.
  - Secure Regional talk groups were discussed stating that 95% of the radios on the system do not have them. ie Region 1-8 Secure. AES encryption must be feature in radio.
  - Suspend programmer ask to be reinstated, more discussion to follow.
  - 56,000 radios on the system, all radios should have all 8 regions programmed into them if the capacity exist.
  - GE stated that the WVSIRN website is going to be updated to include more information.
