Check Background Hunt and RSSI CC Hunt

BER = 4.0 (default)

Hunt Start Time (Hunt) = 300

Hunt Start Time (Idle) = Not changeable version 2

Acceptable RSSI Level = -108 (default)

Good RSSI = -88 (default)

LM1 = 0 (default)

Home RFSS = FE

Home Site = FE

(FE disables the radio from trying to look for a Home RFSS and Home)

PTT Release Hunt = unchecked

Hunt Option > Slot = 99 (insures all adjacent sites are searched)

Hunt Option > Sampling Rate = 7 (number of adjacent sites)
