- 3. Programming or Reprogramming of Cache radios Cache radios should only be reprogrammed after coordination with the SIRN SIEC Technical Committee. There should be no exception to this policy.
- 4. Applying for SIRN licenses FB8 vs FB2 SIRN frequencies should always be licensed as FB8 which is a non-monitored (monitoring takes place via the control computers) while FB2 is a channel that requires monitoring each channel prior to transmitting. The license for Sandyville is only for one pair, and needs five more to be a fully populated site.
- 5. Programming of Announcement Talkgroup At the present time, until Announcement Talkgroup use is better understood, any programming of Announcement Talkgroup usage is prohibited in SIRN.
- 6. POTUS visit showed the need for much better coordination among more entities involved to facilitate coordination of communication to be used not only for the visit, but for continuing day to day operations.
